PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Friday 23rd June 2017

Dear Parents and Carers,

Reports and Parent Teacher Interviews

The semester report provides students, teachers and parents with a clear and concise picture of a student's achievement and progress at a point in time. Teachers make informed and consistent decisions about student progress against the achievement standards using a variety of assessments and observations throughout each term to inform their judgement. The reports map student learning against the achievement standards, and place the student on the learning continuum, that best reflect the student's level of performance and progress.

You may notice some changes to our student reports this semester in line with the implementation of the new Victorian Curriculum that we have been working towards since 2015 at Belgrave South. The Victorian Curriculum now fully replaces the AusVELS curriculum that previous report cards reported against with new curriculum areas included in the cycle of assessment and reporting.

In moving towards the complete implementation of the Victorian Curriculum there has also been adjustment made to the A-E ratings that are displayed on the summary page that shows the graphic representation of a child's progress with a widening of the band of achievement that shows 'above' expected achievement (or a 'B' rating').

I encourage all of our parents and carers to look at the growth in learning that is shown through their place on the continuum rather than the letter rating displayed. Our learning journey never ends and we encourage our students to adopt a growth mindset in relation to their learning. This is the most positive approach for them to take when managing the many challenges that learning and development presents. We all learn at different rates and it is important that we celebrate progress.

Parent/Teacher conferences are occurring on Monday. Information about booking a conference time was communicated via TiqBiz/FlexiBuz early this week. This is a great opportunity to explore the next steps and future learning goals and we look forward to seeing you for your conference on Monday.

Compass School Manager

Everywhere we go we see signs of progress. Things around us are constantly changing and being improved for the better and schools are certainly not immune to this. We are always looking for ways to improve what we do. We are in the early, but very exciting, stages of planning the implementation of Compass School Manager. Compass is a web-based school communication package that will streamline how we record student attendance, support better parent communication, manage the planning of school events and communicate student progress through an online parent portal. You, as parents, will be able to log in and access information related to learning progress and school events anywhere at any time.

It is a really exciting opportunity for us to be able to connect all of these features in a single parent access portal.

Our implementation of Compass will begin with our student attendance, roll marking and student reporting. We will be undertaking a review of our student report cards in Term 3 as we move towards making student progress information available 'live' and in an ongoing way throughout a school term rather than at the end of each semester.

Most families are eligible for Child Care Benefit (CCB) and the 50% Child Care Rebate (CCR). The full fee applies for families who do not apply for and are not eligible for CCB and the CCR. Casual bookings made within 24 Hours incur an extra charge of \$3.30 per session for Before and After Care. All fees are approximate only. Late pick up fees of \$2.00 per minute per child apply. Prices may change at any time.
