Attitude to School Survey

The Attitudes to School survey is an annual student survey provided by the Department of Education and Training to assist schools in gaining an understanding of students' perceptions and experiences of school. We use the survey results to plan programs and activities to make positive improvements to the schooling experience for our students. The Department has updated the survey for 2017 to include important new measures that are known to influence student engagement and performance. This year, students in Years 4, 5 and 6 will participate in the survey through the online survey tool. Each child will be provided with a unique login to complete the survey. The student login is an assigned identifier that may be used by the Department to combine data for research purposes only. Each child's privacy and the confidentiality of the child's survey responses will be protected at all times. No identifiable personal data is included in the survey response file. The survey results will be reported back to the school in Term 3, 2017. No student can be identified in the results reported to schools or in any other report of the data. This year the Attitudes to School survey will be conducted at our school in the week commencing 13 June 2017. The survey will take 20 - 30 minutes to complete. For me, it will be an exercise in patience as in my mind I am already seeing people using this space to experiment and explore and to engage with one another as part of a learning community.

Curriculum News...

Reporting To Parents



On Friday June 23rd your child will bring home their school report on their social and academic progress throughout the first semester. The purpose of the report is to inform parents about what the student has achieved during the past two terms and to indicate areas which may require attention during the coming semester. A copy of the report is also placed your child's file, which moves through the school with them.

Twice a year teachers across the school write written reports to parents. The achievement levels represented for each child is arrived at by a wide variety of assessment strategies. During the last few months the staff has been putting in many hours assessing and evaluating your child's progress in all areas of the curriculum. Teachers make their decisions on your child's work over a period of time, using formal and informal assessment.

The Victorian Curriculum documents provide the basis for our judgments and our reporting to parents. These outcomes are based on what the student **can** do.

Informal testing takes place continually, with teachers making observations, noting students' achievements and difficulties, collecting samples of work and setting specific tasks to evaluate learning and adjusting their teaching accordingly. All children learn at different rates and achieve milestones at different times.

As parents you know that children do not all learn to walk or talk at the same time. Teachers are aware of students' differences and therefore assess what your child can do at the time of reporting.

Please take the time to enjoy your child's report and celebrate their learning.

On Monday June 26th it is a student free day and we will be conducting Three Way Conferences at the school. These take the form of a 15 minute timeslot with the teacher, parent/s and the student.

Parent -teacher interviews provide an excellent opportunity to discuss your child's progress with their teacher and discuss future learning goals for your child.

It is important that home and school work together to support your child's academic and social development. Therefore if at any time you have concerns at about your child's progress please discuss this with your child's teacher.

Most families are eligible for Child Care Benefit (CCB) and the 50% Child Care Rebate (CCR). The full fee applies for families who do not apply for and are not eligible for CCB and the CCR. Casual bookings made within 24 Hours incur an extra charge of \$3.30 per session for Before and After Care. All fees are approximate only. Late pick up fees of \$2.00 per minute per child apply. Prices may change at any time.

How to book

An OSHClub online enrolment form must be completed. Enrol online at www.oshclub.com.au. Once enrolled with OSHClub, log into your account and select to place either a permanent or casual booking.

How to pay

Fees can be paid by Credit Card (VISA or MasterCard) or by direct debit from your nominated bank account. Your account will be automatically charged every 2 weeks for your attendance fees. Usage statements will be available online. A late/penalty fee of \$9.90 will be charged to your credit card or bank account if a transaction is declined.
